Be it ordained by the City Council that the Revised Ordinances of the City of Quincy, 1972, as amended, be further amended by adding in Chapter 6 a new section, 6:04, entitled Displaying Non-domesticated Animals for Entertainment.

DISPLAYING NON-DOMESTICATED ANIMALS FOR ENTERTAINMENT

Section 6:04:10

No living non-domesticated animals shall be displayed for public entertainment or amusement in circuses, carnivals or other similar entities on property owned by the City of Quincy, on City-owned property under lease, or on private property. As used in this paragraph, "displayed" shall include, but is not limited to, animal acts and performances, animal rides and competitive animal races.

Section 6:04:02

If any word, phrase, clause, subsection or section of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 6:04:30

That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all ordinances or part of ordinances, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

DISPLAYING NON-DOMESTICATED ANIMALS FOR ENTERTAINMENT

Section 6:04:40

This ordinance shall not apply to domestic animals including, but not limited to, dogs, cats, horses and farm animals except that no domestic animal shall be used in competitive animal races.

Section 6:04:50

This ordinance shall not apply to exhibits deemed educational by the Massachusetts Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.
